ATVs, Dirt Bikes, Go Karts and EVO Powerboards

Chain Maintenance: All of these products use a chain for final drive to the rear wheel(s). To properly maintain the chain you need to keep it clean, lubricated and adjusted. We sell chain cleaner and lubricant or you can pick it up at most power sport dealers. Chains, especially when new, will stretch and if not adjusted will become so loose they will come off and in the process damage or break other items. Please refer to your owner's manual as to the proper way to keep your chain adjusted.

Oil Maintenance: The EVO Powerboards have a 2-cycle engine and require that you mix 2-cycle oil with the gas for proper lubrication. For longer life you should use a good quality synthetic 2-cycle oil mixed at a ratio of 30 to 1, or 4 ounces of oil to a gallon of gas. All other products use a 4-cycle engine and require that you change the oil on a regular basis. You should change the oil after the first 10 hours of use and every 50 hour thereafter.

Valve Adjustment: All 4-cycle engines have an intake and exhaust valve. As the engine breaks in and is used over time these valves will tighten up and if not adjusted can result in a loss of power or even damage such as a burnt valve. To avoid this from happening we recommend that you have the valves adjusted after the first 20 hours of use and every 100 hours of use thereafter.

Other Maintenance: Due to the nature of these products and the way they are used it is the owner's responsibility to go over the product on a regular basis looking for items that may have loosened up. When found put a small drop of blue Loctite on the item and tighten it back up.

If you follow these basic maintenance recommendations you will enjoy a number of trouble free years of use.
